For U.S. Citizen Documentation:

- Birth certificate, if born in the United States, Puerto Rico, Guam, U.S. Virgin Islands, American Samoa, Swain's Island, or Northern Mariana Islands
- Valid U.S. passport
- Certificate of Citizenship
- Certificate of Naturalization
- Form FS-240 (Consular Report of Birth Abroad)
- Form FS-545 (Certificate of Birth-Foreign Service)
- Form DS-1350 (Certification of Report of Birth)

For Eligible Noncitizen Documentation:

- Form I-551 (Permanent Resident/Resident Alien Card)
- Valid U.S. passport stamped "Non Citizen National" or "Processed for I-551"
- Valid foreign passport with unexpired MRIV stamp "Temporary I-551"
- Form I-94 or I-94A (Arrival Departure Record) stamped "Processed for I-551"
- Form I-94 or I-94A with status of:
 - A) Refugee
 - B) Asylum Status
 - C) Conditional Entrant
 - D) Parolee
 - E) Cuban-Haitian Entrant

If you are in the U.S. only on an F1 or F2 student visa, a J1 or J2 exchange visitor visa, or a series G visa (pertaining to international organizations) you are not eligible for federal, state, or institutional aid through the Office of Student Financial Aid and Scholarships at Ohio University. However, if you are a graduate student, you should contact the Graduate Student Services Office to inquire about graduate scholarships or stipends.
